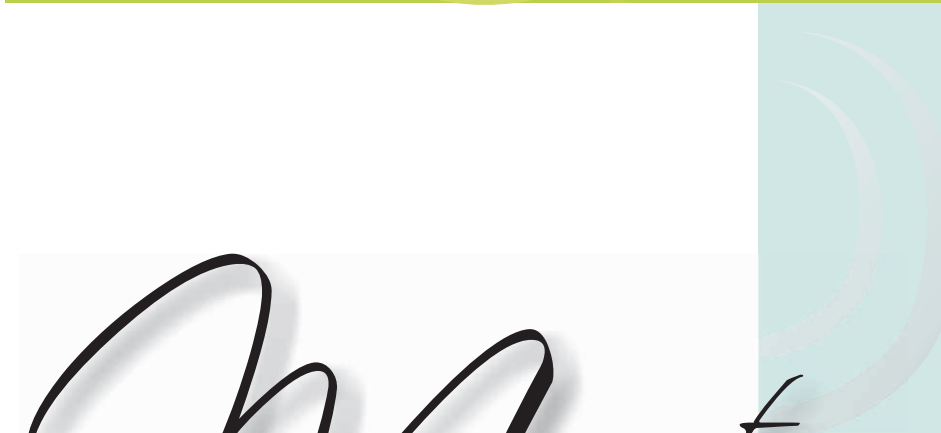
Music Drama Day Camp... July 26-31, 2010
